

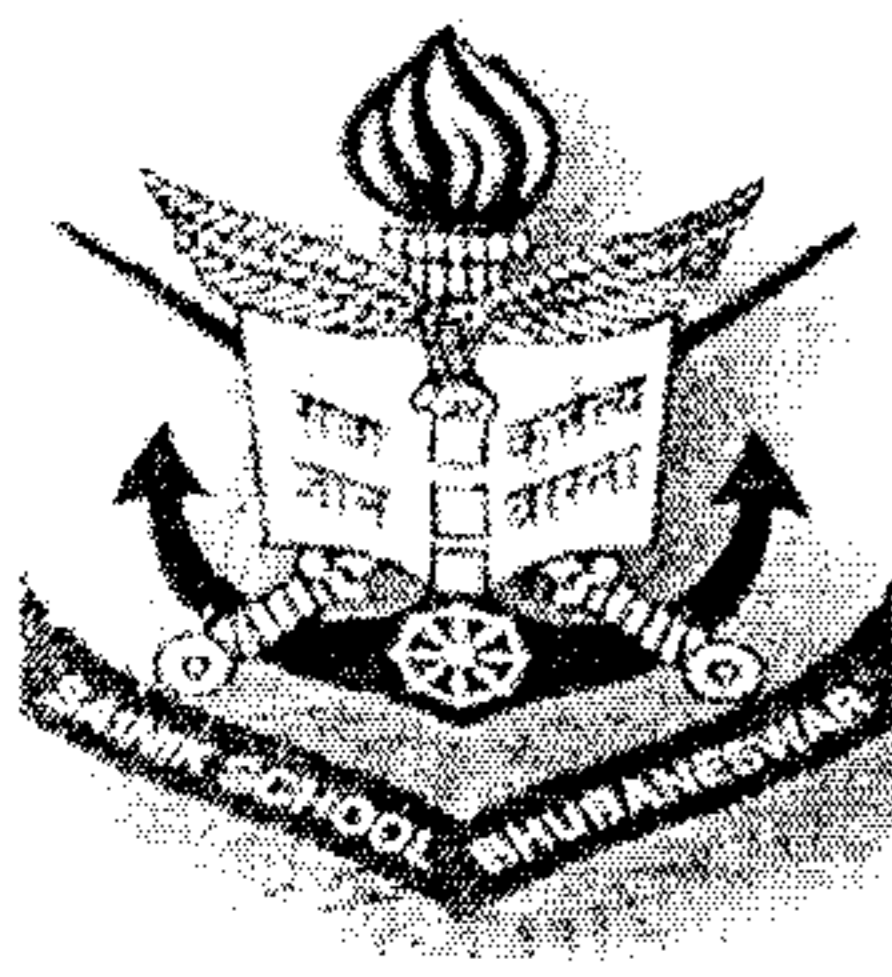

Sir,

1. Reference Rule 3.22 of Sainik Schools Society Rules and Regulations 1997 and Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence, Govt of India letter 5(20)/2018/D (SSC) dated 11 Sep 18 (copy enclosed).
2. As per the directives of the Board of Governors, Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence, Govt of India, the next **OMR Based All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2019** will be held on **06 Jan 2019 (Sunday)**. There are approximately 100 vacancies available for admission to Class VI in the School for the Academic Session 2019-20. A pamphlet giving the relevant information about the Entrance Examination is enclosed.
3. With effect from the Academic Session 2019-20, the age criterion for admission to Classes VI and IX has been changed, ie 10-12 years for Class VI and 13-15 years for Class IX as on 31 March of the year of admission. As per the existing reservation policy, 15% seats are reserved for SC, 7 ½% seats are reserved for ST. Of the remaining, 25% seats are reserved for Serving Defence Personnel including Ex-Servicemen. 67% of the seats left over after deduction of SC and ST seats are earmarked for Home State candidates. The remaining 33% seats are open for candidates from Other States.
4. In order to publicise the information about the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2019-20, the following measures are requested at your end under government expenses:-

(a) The contents in the enclosed pamphlet may be published in the popular local Odia and English newspapers.

- (b) The information may please be broadcasted regularly through Doordarshan, All India Radio and local news channels all over Odisha up to 26 Nov 18.
- (c) Slides containing information related to the Entrance Exam may be screened in various Cinema Halls throughout the State of Odisha.
- (d) **'SAINIK SCHOOLS WAY'** documentary film available with the Director, Department of Information and Public Relations, Govt of Odisha and Regional Office of Directorate of Field Publicity, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Govt of India at Bhubaneswar may be screened at appropriate places for information of the target group.
- (e) Suitable instructions may please be issued to Principals/Headmasters of the State Govt Primary and Middle Schools through the District Education Officers of all the districts in Odisha to transmit the information about the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2019-20 and encourage the boys between 10-12 years age group to apply for admission to Sainik School Bhubaneswar.
- (f) Co-ordination with Department of SC & ST Development and Minorities and Backward Classes Welfare, Govt of Odisha for the benefit of children from SC, ST categories and socio-economically weaker sections.

5. Positive efforts of concerned agencies of the government will ensure attracting meritorious students from all over Odisha to take admission in Sainik School Bhubaneswar to achieve the following vision and mission behind establishment of Sainik School Bhubaneswar in the State of Odisha:-

- (a) **Vision**. To offer quality education to the children of rural masses and to develop qualities of body, mind and character which will enable the young boys to become good and useful citizen and eventually be a feeder to National Defence Academy and Naval Academy.
- (b) **Mission**. To bring public school education to the door step of the common man and send maximum number of its cadets to National Defence Academy and Naval Academy. To provide quality education to the children from myriad backgrounds to enable boys from economically weaker sections of the society to take up an illustrious career as officer in the Armed Forces of the nation and other celebrated professions with an emphasis on all-round development of the cadets so that they consistently strive hard to live up to the expectations of their parents and nation at large.

Subject : Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2019-2020 Session

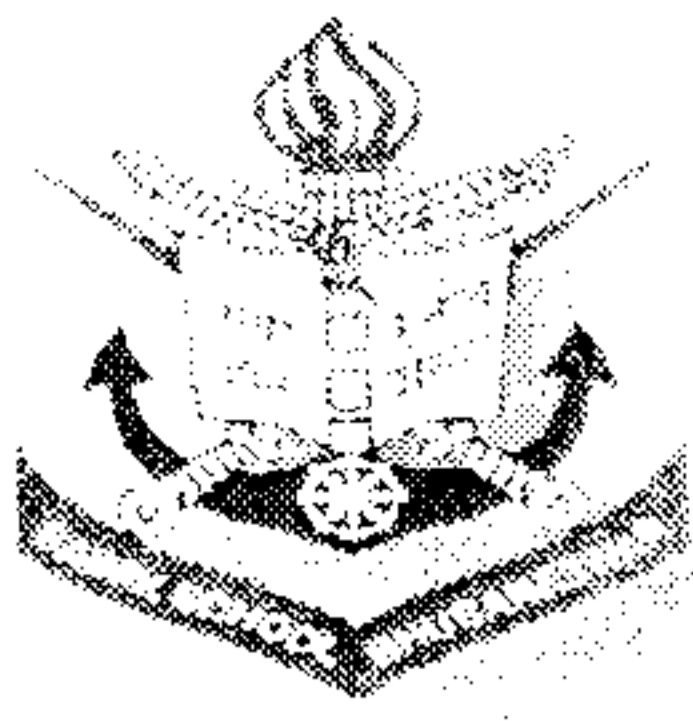
The Sainik Schools scheme came into existence in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing boys from socio-economically backward section of the Society for a career in the officer cadre of the Armed Forces and to remove regional imbalances in recruitment to the Armed Forces. At present, there are 28 Sainik Schools one each in 18 States (except in Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Meghalaya, Goa, Tripura and Sikkim) & two each in Bihar, Haryana, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan. These schools are residential Public Schools and affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education to impart education upto Class XII under 10+2 pattern of education.

2. Admission of boys in these schools is made every year in classes VI and IX on the basis of All India Entrance Examination conducted annually. The Entrance Examination for 2019-2020 for both classes VI & IX will be held on 06-01-2019. In accordance with the decision of Board of Governors, boys in order to be eligible to take the exam for admission to classes VI and IX should be between the age of 10 to 12 years and 13 to 15 years on 31st March, 2019 respectively. Necessary advertisement inviting application will be issued by the Sainik Schools individually in October 2018. The last date of receipt of application will be 01st December, 2018. 15% and 7 ½% seats are reserved for admission of boys belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes respectively. Out of the remaining, 67% of the seats will be reserved for boys from the State in which the Sainik School is located. Balance 33% left over of seats will be thrown open to boys from other States and Union Territories in the ratio of their male population any unutilized seats in this category will be merged with home States seats in order of merit. 25% seats are also reserved for the boys of service personnel including ex-servicemen.

3. The admission of boys in Sainik Schools is made strictly in accordance with merit in the Entrance Examination and subject to medical fitness. The Central and State Govts. have instituted liberal scholarship schemes for education in these schools. In order to have boys with high merit, it would be desirable to give wide publicity to the Entrance Exam so that a large number of candidates are attracted. While Sainik Schools will make all efforts in this behalf, you are requested to kindly direct your publicity department, District Collectors and Officials of the Social Welfare and Education Deptt. to give as much publicity as possible. I am instructing the Principals to contact you to supply necessary material required for publicity. All India Radio is also being requested to announce the Programme of this examination in their weekly bulletins for the Armed Forces. The Director General, National Cadet Corps too has been requested to issue instructions to all the Directorates of NCC for rendering assistance usual in the conduct of examination. The State Govt. may also like to advice the Principals on the adequacy of number of centers for the examination so as to attract the boys from backward regions of the States / Union Territories. State Govt. may also like to clearly indicate to the Principals of the Sainik Schools located in their area whether State / UT scholarship will be available for education to the Sainik Schools out-side the State / UT in case vacancies are offered to boys of their domicile.

- Online applications are invited in the prescribed form for admission to **CLASS-VI** through AISS Entrance Examination to be held on **06 JAN 2019 (SUNDAY)**. The AISSEE will be on OMR based system which will have Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) with four options.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** Boys born between **01 APR 2007 AND 31 MAR 2009** are eligible for **CLASS-VI**.
- **AVAILABILITY OF SEATS FOR CLASS VI: 100 (Approx)**. May change based on actual availability of vacancies at the time of admission.
- **RESERVATION:** SC- 15% of the total seats, ST- 7½ % of the total seats. Out of remaining 67% seats will be reserved for Home State candidates. Balance 33% left over of seats will be open to other States and Union Territories as per Sainik Schools Society guidelines. 25% seats are reserved for children of service personnel including Ex-servicemen.
- **ONLINE REGISTRATION FEE:** ₹400/- (for General/Defence) ₹250/- (for SC/ST).

i) The above dates are to be strictly adhered to. No extension of date will be granted.

ii) 'Surplus' means qualified candidates who cannot be admitted in the school of domicile, being low in merit and 'deficient' means lack of qualified candidates to fill in the available vacancies in each category. The deficient schools would fill in their vacancies based on combined merit list prepared from the surplus candidates willing for admission in that school in each category available from all schools.

2. The Entrance Examination will be held for admission to class VI & IX. Boys who are between the age of 10 to 12 years and 13 to 15 years respectively on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought are eligible to take the Entrance Examination. For admission to Class IX, the boys should be studying in Class VIII in a recognised school. Admission will be made strictly in order of merit only in classes VI and IX. In case the Entrance Examination cannot be conducted in any State/UT on account of administrative problem, a separate order will be issued to conduct another Entrance Examination on a date fixed by the Honorary Secretary.

3. The Registration charge will be included in the selling price of the prospectus-cum-application forms at the following rates:-

a) General and Defence Category : Rs.400/-

b) SC/ST : Rs.250/-

4. Previous year question papers can be obtained from the Principal on payment as prescribed by the Sainik Schools Society. It may, however, be noted that from last year onwards the format of exam is being changed to OMR based exam. All Principals are requested to send a specimen copy of the prospectus and application form to the Society as soon as the same is published in the newspapers.

5. In case boys who are qualified but low in merit in schools of their domicile and whose parents are willing to admit their wards in other Sainik Schools, will be required to give an undertaking that "they are willing to admit their sons/wards as full paying (fees) cadets in other Sainik Schools of their choice and under any circumstances will not seek inter-school transfer till the end of completion of studies of their wards in the Sainik School once they are selected/admitted". They will be allowed to identify/indicate any three Sainik School of their choice/preference as first, second and third in order of their choice. This clause will be included in the prospectus and the application form accordingly.

6. The intake into class IX will be so regulated that after passing class X, when the students of class IX this year reach class XI and XII, the number of sections in classes XI and XII need not be increased at any rate from what exists in the school at present. Similarly, the authorised strength of the school should not be exceeded. Category wise number of vacancies in class VI and IX available in the school may be determined and intimated to the Society by 29th September, 2018. The number of vacancies may also clearly be indicated in the prospectus as well as in the advertisement.

11. The minimum qualifying marks for general category candidates as well as children of Defence Services Personnel and ex-servicemen will be 25% in each subject with 40% in aggregate unless these qualifying standards are revised or amended by issue of written directions by the Honorary Secretary. In the case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates, minimum qualifying standards are not required and they will be admitted on the basis of inter-se merit at the Entrance Examination within these categories. In case a SC/ST candidate comes in the general merit on his own, he would be admitted against general seat and will not be adjusted against the reserved share of SC/ST seats.

12. 300 marks prescribed for Written Examination for class VI and 400 marks for class IX. The merit list for admission to the Sainik School would be compiled on the basis of marks obtain by the candidate. In case there is a tie with regard to overall marks, the marks for mathematics would be considered. In case there is a tie here also the marks for English for Class IX and Intelligence Test for class VI will be considered and thereafter the marks for General Science for class IX and Language for class VI. In case there is a tie there also the boy younger in age will be selected. Marks obtained in the written test will determine his position in the final merit list.

13. It should be made clear in the prospectus as well as in the newspapers while declaring the final results that detailed marks list can be supplied only to the parent / legal guardian of the candidates on payment of Rs.100/- through crossed Postal Order / DD in favour of the School concerned.

14. Reservation

- a) 15% of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes and 7½% seats for Scheduled Tribes.
- b) Out of the remaining, 67% of the seats will be reserved for boys from the State in which the Sainik School is located. Balance 33% left over of seats will be thrown open to boys from other States and Union Territories in the ratio of their male population. Any unutilized seats in this category will be merged with home State seats (In this connection, please refer to this office letter No. 4(1)/SSS/2016) dated 5th July, 2017) in order of merit.
- c) 25% seats are reserved for children of service personnel including Ex-servicemen.

15. The Principals will take up the matter of fixation of centers with the State Govt. The State Government and NCC Dte. will separately be addressed by them to provide necessary assistance for the conduct of the Entrance Examination.

16. It should be noted that the medical examination in respect of the candidates are completed within prescribed time frame, so that the candidates and guardians are not inconvenienced. The school will not be responsible for any delay in receiving medical examination notice/letters by the cadets, including postal delay. The cadets who intends to appear in the medical examination other than the date mentioned in the notice/letter will not be allowed to appear in the medical examination.

17. Your attention is invited to the contents of the paper on reforms in Entrance Examination systems, Sainik School, which was circulated vide our letter No. 5(5)/2003/D(SSC) dated 26th September, 2003. The directions given therein will strictly be complied with.

7. Wide publicity may be given about this examination particularly the change in this format of this exam from subject to OMR based through Akashvani, Doordarshan and by means of advertisements in the leading newspapers, both in Hindi & English as well as by posters and handbills and by any other means suited to the local conditions. State Directors/Directorates of Publicity may be contacted for having press handouts issued. The reservations of seats for SC/ST boys and the availability of scholarships from various sources may be explained properly. Each school will be responsible for making its own advertisement arrangements indicating that the school does not patronise any coaching institutes/agent and the admissions will be strictly in accordance with the merit and medical fitness of candidates in the Entrance Examination. The schools are instructed to sell Application Forms through internet also with the condition that parent would deposit registration fees in the form of Demand Draft alongwith completed form or submit proof of having deposited fee online.

8. The school will make its own arrangements for the conduct of the Entrance Examination. The responsibility for publicity and the conduct of the examination in respect of the following States and the Union Territories where Sainik Schools are not established will be that of the schools indicated against each:-


9. The written Entrance Examination will be held on 06th January, 2019 from 1000 onwards. Detailed programme will be intimated by the conducting Schools. Due to change in format total number of questions in class VI as well as IX may change.

10. Medium of Examination for Class VI examinations will be English, Hindi. The question papers for Class VI will continue to be set in English and all the recognised official languages. But question papers for class IX will be set in English only and students are required to answer in English.

18. Staff children seeking admission to class VI and IX as day scholars will also appear in the Entrance Examination. Their admission will be carried out subject to their qualifying in the Entrance Examination and in accordance with the existing Rules and Regulations on the subject.

19. Demand for question paper(s) is required to be forwarded by the Principals to Sainik School, Satara under intimation to Sainik School Society by 30th November, 2018.

20. The Principals are directed to indicate all the above terms and conditions in the prospectus for All India Entrance Examination 2019-2020 session and send the compliance report with a copy of the prospectus-cum-application form to the Sainik Schools Society, immediately.
