**ORDER**

**Whereas** it is imperative to adopt strict social distancing and isolation measures to contain the spread of COVID-19, which is playing havoc in many countries across the world, including India,

**And Whereas**, the Government of Odisha, vide Revenue & DM (Disaster Management) Department Notification No.1706/R&DM(DM) dated 13th March 2020, has declared COVID-19 as a 'Disaster' under section 2(d) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 for the State of Odisha;

**And Whereas**, the Government of Odisha, in exercise of powers conferred under section 2 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 and the Odisha COVID-19 Regulation, 2020 has ordered lockdown of the entire State vide order No. 3057/R&DM(DM) Dated 01.06.2020 till midnight of 30<sup>th</sup> of June, 2020,

**And whereas**, detection of significant numbers of COVID-19 cases in the districts of Bhadrak in last few days requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public ;

**And whereas**, the State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA) has authorized the Chief Secretary of the State to make any addition or alteration to the Order No.2035/R&DM(DM) dated. 27.03.2020 on measures for containment of COVID-19 in the State;

**And Whereas**, the State Govt. has extended the lockdown in Containment Zones till midnight of 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2020 and allowed more activities in non containment areas in a calibrated manner vide Order No.3856/R& DM (DM) dt.30.06.2020 of Chief Secretary, Odisha

**Now therefore**, in pursuance of afore mentioned Govt. Order and in partial modification of this Office Order No.653/Judl. dated.30.06.2020 and in the interest of public health it is hereby ordered that , all Saturdays and Sundays during the month of July-2020 are **declared as "weekend complete shutdown"**. **The shutdown will be effective from 5.00AM of every Saturday to 5.00AM of every Monday till 31.07.2020.**

During this shutdown period, **all other activities/ Institutions including all Govt offices of Bhadrak district** shall remain closed with the following exceptions:

- All medical establishments including hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, including medicine stores. Movement of Ambulance and all medical personnel.
- District and Municipal Administration/ Police/ Fire Services
- Central & State Government officials on emergency duty
- Telecom services
- Petrol pumps



- Print and Electronic Media identified by SP, Bhadrak
- Water Supply, sanitation and sewerage workers
- Electricity supply and distribution
- Movement of goods and good carriers, whether loaded or unloaded
- Industrial establishments, factories and related construction activities
- Service sector industries, including IT/ITeS, Hotel & Hospitality Units
- All Agriculture, Horticulture & Allied activities
- All Dairy, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Allied activities
- Movement of rail
- Road transport on highways, road movement of transiting vehicles
- Movement of Public Transport, private vehicles and taxis (including cabs by aggregators like Ola, Uber, etc.) to and from railway station and bus stands, for facilitating movement of passengers by rail and road.
- Marriages and funerals, with permission by District Administration.
- Safety and protection of vulnerable persons
- Movement of any person in case of medical or other emergency
- ATMs and critical financial institutions like RBI, Clearing Houses
- Operations of Airports, Railway Stations, Bus Terminals and their associated offices, movement of associated personnel and activities
- Home Delivery of food by restaurants and aggregators such as Zamato, Swiggy etc.
- Newspapers hawkers between 5am and 8 am only
- LPG distribution, home delivery of cooking gas and associated facilities, personnel and vehicular movement.

**N.B:** The officials engaged in emergency duty or associated with essential public services shall display a copy of office order issued by District Administration/ Head of Office, on their vehicles / carry it along with them while move out.

Any violation of this order shall entail prosecution under the penal provisions of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and IPC.

This will come into immediate effect.
