And Whereas, the Chief Secretary, Odisha has authorised Collector & D.M., Bhadrak to make any addition or alternation to the Order No.2111/R&DM(DM) /Dt.03.04.2020 on measure for containment of COVID-19 in Bhadrak District.

And Whereas, detection of 05 (Five)no. of COVID-19 case in **Bonth / Tihidi Block** area requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public.

And Whereas, (05) no. positive case of COVID-19 detected in afore mentioned Blocks of Bhadrak District today as persons with travel history and to contain any possible spread of COVID-19, it is necessary to make the affected areas as Containment Zones and restrict people from entering into and going out of the Containment Zones,

And Whereas, out of the above (05) five cases (01) one case belongs to Sendhatira Covid Care Centres in Bonth Block where public entry is strictly.

Now Therefore, in large public interest we being the empowered Officer declare the following TMCs as Containment Zones.

No. of persons undergoing Institutional Quarantine at the venue shall not be released till the Containment Zone is de-notified. During this period no new person shall be admitted at the above TMC under Institutional Quarantine.


