**ORDER**

**Whereas**, Govt. of Odisha in exercise of power conferred U/S 2, 3 & 4 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 has promulgated Odisha COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 for Containment of COVID-19.

**And Whereas**, the National Disaster Management Authority, Govt. of India in exercise of power conferred U/S 6(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 has directed the State Govt./ State Authorities to take measures for ensuring social distancing so as to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and directed the National Executive Committee under the said Act to issue necessary Guidelines in this regard.

**And Whereas**, Govt. of Odisha has issued various measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 vide Order No. 2035/ R&DM dated 27.03.2020.

**And Whereas**, the Chief Secretary, Odisha has authorised Collector & D.M., Bhadrak to make any addition or alternation to the Order No.2111/R&DM(DM) /Dt.03.04.2020 on measure for containment of COVID-19 in Bhadrak District.

**And Whereas**, detection of 01 (one)no. of COVID-19 case in Bhadrak Block area requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public.

**And Whereas**, 01 (One)no. positive case of COVID-19 detected in afore mentioned Block of Bhadrak District today as local contact case and to contain any possible spread of COVID-19, it is necessary to make the affected areas as Containment Zone and restrict people from entering into and going out of the Containment Zone,

**Now Therefore**, in large public interest we being the empowered Officer declare the following areas as Containment Zone.

- Home or Institutional Quarantining of individuals based on risk assessment by Medical Officer. The risk assessment will be based on symptoms, contact with confirmed cases, and travel history.
- Testing of all cases with Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), ILI and other symptoms specified by MoHFW.
- House to house surveillance by special teams constituted for this purpose.
- Clinical management of all cases as per protocol.
- Counselling and educating people; and establishing effective communication strategies.

**Any violation of this order shall entail prosecution under the penal provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and I.P.C.**

**And Whereas**, detection of 04 (Four)nos. of COVID-19 cases in **Basudevpur / Dhamnagar/ Bhandaripokhari Block** areas requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public.

**And Whereas**, (04) no. positive cases of COVID-19 detected in afore mentioned Blocks of Bhadrak District today as persons with travel history and to contain any possible spread of COVID-19, it is necessary to make the affected areas as Containment Zones and restrict people from entering into and going out of the Containment Zones,

**Now Therefore**, in large public interest we being the empowered Officer declare the following TMCs as Containment Zones.

Further, the Jagannath High School, Chingudipur under Bishnupur GP in Bhandaripokhari Block and Eram Cyclone Shelter under Ertal GP in Basudevpur Block which are already declared as Containment Zones vide this Office Order No.9450/Emg. dt.13/07/2020 & No.9071/Emg. 05.07.2020 respectively due to detection of fresh case of COVID-19 in these TMCs, the period of contentment in this TMC is hereby extended by 14 days w.e.f 19/07/2020.

- Clinical management of all cases as per protocol.
- Counselling and educating people; and establishing effective communication strategies.

**No. of persons undergoing Institutional Quarantine at the venue shall not be released till the Containment Zone is de-notified. During this period no new person shall be admitted at the above TMC under Institutional Quarantine.**
