ORDER

Whereas, in pursuance of the directions of the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), the National Executive Committee, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 10(2)(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, has issued revised guidelines vide Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29.06.2020 to extend the lockdown in Containment Zones up to 31.07.2020, and to re-open more activities in a calibrated manner in areas outside Containment Zones;

And Whereas, Government of Odisha vide Order No. 3856/R&DM dated 30.6.2020 has issued guidelines for COVID-19 management in the state till 31.7.2020.

And whereas, detection of significant numbers of COVID-19 cases in the districts of Bhadrak in last few days requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public ;

And whereas, the weekend shut down in Bhadrak District is already in force vide this Office Order No. 9084/Emg. dt.06.07.2020,

And whereas, a significant rise in COVID-19 cases has been reported from across Bhadrak District recently,

Now therefore, in large public interest and in continuation of aforementioned weekend Office Order and Order No 8794/Emg Dated 30.06.20 in order to contain and prevent further spread of COVID 19, we being the authorized officer do hereby ordered that there will be lock down in rest five block Hqrs of Bhadrak District i.e Chandbali (Chandabali NAC), Tihidi, Basudevpur (Basudevpur Municipality), Bonth and Bhandaripokhari **from 22/07/2020 to 31/07/2020** with the following restrictions and exemptions:

No movement of individual from 2PM is allowed except the following exempted categories.

1. Government of India establishment

- i. Post Offices
- ii. Telecom Services including their maintenance offices and Movement of associated personnel
- iii. Banks with 50% strength will function till 2 PM and customers service till 1 PM
- iv. ATMs Services
- v. Other GoI offices with reduced staff

2. State Government Establishment

- i. State Governments with reduced staff as per directions of SRC and GA & PG Department
- ii. Block/Municipal Administration/ Police/ Fire Services/ Government Officials on emergency and COVID duty.

Utilities and Essential Services

- i. All medical establishments including Govt. and private hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, including Movement of ambulance and all medical personnel including Doctors & Paramedic. Medicine store can open till 10 PM. However, medicine stores within CHCs and PHCs shall function 24/7. However, home delivery of medicine can be made 24/7 with due permission from Local Authority
- ii. Water supply, sanitation and sewerage workers
- iii. Power generation, transmission and distribution(NESCO)

3. Transport

- i. Movement of sea and rail transport. Operations of Railway Stations, Bus Terminals and their associated offices, movement of associated personnel and activities
- ii. Road transport and movement of transiting vehicles on highways
- iii. Persons with urgent medical or other works can enter or exit block hqrs area by showing valid documents.
- iv. Movement of goods and goods carriers, whether loaded or unloaded
- v. Movement of Public Transport, private vehicles and taxis (including cabs by aggregators like Ola, Uber, etc.) to and from airports, railway station and bus stands/ stops for facilitating movement of passengers by air, rail and road

4. Vegetables, Food & Grocery shop.

- 1. Only Vegetables, Grocery, Milk and Milk products and Shops dealing with Fruits, Fish, Meat, Chicken and Egg shall open from 5AM to 1 PM subject to strict adherence of norms of physical distance and other COVID 19 safety protocols. No other shops and commercial establishment except the above shall be opened.**
2. Home Delivery of packed food, groceries, vegetables, milk and milk products is allowed till 6PM (except on shutdown days) with due permission from local Authority and on production of valid identity Card.

5. Economic and other activities

- i. Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry Services and allied activities like opening of pesticides and fertilizers shops
- ii. All industrial units, factories and construction activities
- iii. Petrol pumps
- iv. LPG delivery
- v. Dhabas on the NH for take-away
- vi. IT/ITeS units with bare minimum staff for critical operations
- vii. Operation of hotels and hospitality units, including their associated offices, movement of staff and associated personnel
- viii. Operations of E-commerce establishments such as Flip kart, Amazon etc., including their warehousing and delivery activities
- ix. Print and Electronic Media identified by District Police
- x. Marriages and Funerals with due permission from the local police station

6. All enforcing authorities to note that these strict restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not that of goods.

7. No person is allowed to enter the block hqrs area or move within its jurisdiction during the lockdown time except on medical and urgent grounds on production of relevant documents from 2.00 PM onwards on week days. Penalty shall be imposed on the violators @Rs 1,000/- for two wheelers and Rs 2,000/- for four wheelers.

8. Strict enforcement of the lockdown measures:

ADMs, Sub-Collector and SDM, Tahasildar, Bhadrak and Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality are hereby authorized to take all necessary actions for enforcement and implementation of the aforesaid measures. Local police shall render necessary assistance as and when required by the aforementioned officers.

9. Penal provisions: Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against in accordance with the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions such as Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, as applicable. Fines can be imposed and collected by enforcements squads headed by ADM, SDM, Tahasildar/Additional Tahasildar, BDO, Executive Officers, Officers authorized by Executive Officer, PEOs of Block and Police officers in the rank of ASI and above.

10. The Order No8794/Emg. dated 30.06-2020 will continue to be applicable in the other part of the district till 31.07.2020
