ORDER

Whereas, Govt. of Odisha in exercise of power conferred U/S 2, 3 & 4 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 has promulgated Odisha COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 for Containment of COVID-19.

And Whereas, the National Disaster Management Authority, Govt. of India in exercise of power conferred U/S 6(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 has directed the State Govt./ State Authorities to take measures for ensuring social distancing so as to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and directed the National Executive Committee under the said Act to issue necessary Guidelines in this regard.

And Whereas, Govt. of Odisha has issued various measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 vide Order No. 2035/ R&DM dated 27.03.2020.

And Whereas, the Chief Secretary, Odisha has authorised Collector & D.M., Bhadrak to make any addition or alternation to the Order No.2111/R&DM(DM) /Dt.03.04.2020 on measure for containment of COVID-19 in Bhadrak District.

And Whereas, detection of 04 (Four)nos. of COVID-19 cases in Bhadrak Block & Bhadrak Municipality area requires aggressive contact tracing, quarantine, testing and isolation as well as containment in the interest of health of general public.

And Whereas, 04(Four) nos. positive cases of COVID-19 detected in afore mentioned Block /ULB of Bhadrak District today as local contact case and to contain any possible spread of COVID-19, it is necessary to make the affected areas as Containment Zone and restrict people from entering into and going out of the Containment Zone,

Now Therefore, in large public interest we being the empowered Officer declare the following areas as Containment Zone.

- No public shall be allowed to move into the Containment Zone and inhabitants within the Containment Zone shall not move out.
- All the inhabitants within the Containment Zone shall strictly remain in home. All the shopping establishment of whatsoever nature shall be closed immediately. The supply of essential and medical requirements will be ensured through various teams formed by the District Administration.
- All the Govt. & Private Institutions located within the boundary of the containment zone is hereby closed forthwith.
- Concerned BDO / Executive Officer shall be the supervising Officers of Containment Zone.

The following activities shall be carried out in the Containment Zone.

- Contact Tracing
- Home or Institutional Quarantining of individuals based on risk assessment by Medical Officer. The risk assessment will be based on symptoms, contact with confirmed cases, and travel history.
- Testing of all cases with Severe Active Respiratory Infection (SARI), ILI and other symptoms specified by MoHFW.
- House to house surveillance by special teams constituted for this purpose.
- Clinical management of all cases as per protocol.
- Counselling and educating people; and establishing effective communication strategies.

Any violation of this order shall entail prosecution under the penal provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and I.P.C.
