Proceeding of the District Level Procurement Committee (DLPC) meeting held on 17.11.2023 at 10.30 A.M in the Zilla Parishad Conference Hall, to finalize the action plan for smooth Paddy Procurement Operation in Bhadrak District for the KMS 2023-24.

- The District Level Procurement Committee (DLPC) meeting as scheduled was held on 17.11.2023 at 10.30 A.M in the Zilla Parishad Conference Hall, Bhadrak under the Chairmanship of the Collector, Bhadrak to finalize action plan for smooth Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2023-24.
- The Hon'ble Chairperson of District Planning Board-cum- MLA Chandabali, Hon'ble MLA Basudevpur, Hon'ble MLA Bhandaripokhari, Hon'ble MLA Bhadrak, Representative of Hon'ble M.P Bhadrak, Representative of Hon'ble MLA Dhamnagar., President Zilla Parishad, Bhadrak, CDO-cum-EO, Zilla Parishad Bhadrak, two farmer's representatives, Representatives of Rice Millers and other members of DLPC were present & participated in the meeting. The attendance of the members is attached at Annexure-"A".
- At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all members & participants and instructed the CSO-cum-DM to put forth the status of Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2022-23 & thereafter the action plan for the current KMS for discussion & approval.
- The CSO-cum-DM with due permission of the Chair, apprised the Committee the status of Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2022-23 & thereby the action plan for current KMS through power point presentation as below-

The CSO, Bhadrak appraised the Committee that, the Land & Bank Accounts of the farmers has already been completed and suspected Land Verification through OPLS (Odisha Paddy Land Survey) will be carried out after uploading of Land list by Govt in Online portal. for the KMS 2023-24.

4. Allocation of Target for Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2023-24.

The CSO, Bhadrak appraised the Committee that, in pursuance of the L.No 18204 dated 13.11.2023 of Govt in FS & CW Department, Govt have allocated a Target to the tune of 162000 M.T. in terms of rice in 1st Phase, equivalent to 235235.294 M.T paddy for procurement during the KMS 2023-24

5. Minimum Support Price (MSP) of Paddy for the KMS 2023-24.

In pursuance of the Food & Procurement Policy, the Govt of India has announced Minimum Support Price (MSP) for different varieties of paddy confirming to Fair Average Quality (FAQ) for the KMS 2023-24 as below-

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- (i) Common : Rs 2183/- Per Quintal,
- (ii) Grade "A" : Rs 2203/- Per Quintal.

Further, the Payment of total Paddy Cost sold to the Societies has to be made to farmers concerned through Online Mode within 24 to 48 hours of acceptance of TP-cum-Acceptance Notes by Millers to the Bank Accounts of the farmers.

6. Infrastructure facilities / Quality Testing Equipments: -

In pursuance of the Food & Procurement Policy, each selected PACS, GPLF & WSHG involved in Paddy Procurement Operation, should have designated place of business with following infrastructural facilities-

- (i) Truckable Road for transportation,
- (ii) Computer with internet Connectivity
- (iii) Inverter in order to avoid power cut as alternative arrangement
- (iv) Toilet mostly for lady farmers as mandatory with Drinking water facility.
- (v) CC TV provision at Mandi point in order to maintain transparency in Procurement Operation.
- (vi) Analysis Kit, Moisture meter, Mini Grader, Sample collecting plate, Set of sieves, Sample Divider, Tarpaulin & polythene etc.
- (vi) Office room with waiting space & sitting arrangement.

Besides, the RMCs will appoint Quality Analysts to each PPCs & provide all Quality testing equipments for quality check of farmers paddy prior to commencement of Procurement Operation.

7. Formation of Society Level Procurement Committee (SoLPC)-

The BDO of the Block under which the society is located will notify the formation of the Society Level Procurement Committee (SoLPC) comprising of the members.

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8. **Mandi Labour Charges:** - The Mandi Labour Charges will be paid to the stake holder as per approved rate of the Corporation, who will actually perform the Mandi Handling Operation at the PPCs. The CSO appraised the Committee that, during KMS 2022-23, Mandi Labour Charges such as hipping of paddy, re-bagging, weighment etc was done by the PPC & loading of re-bagged paddy to the miller's vehicles and unloading of paddy at the mill points was done by the millers. The Millers Association, Bhadrak has presently represented & requested for reimbursement of the Mandi Labour charges in favour of the PPCs as they are facing difficulties to deploy labourers at each Mandis.
9. **Lifting of procured Paddy from PPCs to Rice Mill points:-** In pursuance of the L.No 12069 dated 14.08.2023 of OSCSC Ltd, Bhubaneswar, Govt have decided to appoint Paddy Transport Contractor for transportation of Procured paddy from PPCs to Rice Mill points through Transport Contactor. As such, tenders through GeM Portal was conducted twice, but no bidder has been participated in tender process. Accordingly, the matter was conveyed to the Managing Director, OSCSC Ltd, Bhubaneswar to take decision in this regard.
10. **Formation of Control Room:** - Control Room for redressal of farmers issues has already been constituted have being Tel Phone No 06784-251424 in the Office of the CSO, Bhadrak vide Office Order No 4988 dated 04.11.2023 of the Collector, Bhadrak. Moreover, Control Room in the Office of the ARCS, Bhadrak is being operational having Tel Phone No 06784-299947 for the purpose.

Apart from that, one IVRS Tool free number-"1967" will be operational, to redress the issues of the farmers at state level.

11. **PPCs not willing to participate in Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2023-24.**

The CSO, Bhadrak appraised the Committee that the following PPCs participated in Procurement Operation for the KMS 2022-23 are not willing to participate in the Current KMS 2023-24.

13. **Suggestion of the Members:** -

The Hon'ble Chairperson of District Planning Board-cum- MLA Chandabali during course of discussion, emphasized on Katni & Chhatni made by few millers on plea of FAQ norms & should be avoided. In addition to this, the Hon'ble chairperson also impressed to regulate TOKENS properly to avoid heavy rush at PPC points & deployment of adequate Millers at Mandis functioning at Dhamara side especially. He also emphasized on provisions of Godowns at each PPC for storage of Paddy & payment of total Mandi Handling Charges to concerned PPCs. In addition to this, he also suggested to open new PPCs at Narendrapur & Sahapur G.P under Tihidi Block.

The Hon'ble MLA Bhandaripokhari emphasized on availability of infrastructures with all PPCs & priority to be given to Purusandha SCS. He also suggested for opening of new PPCs in each GP and focused on addressal of FAQ

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issues. He also focused on proper training to DEOs & Secretaries & chances has to be given to new PACS / WSHG to participate in procurement operation.

The Hon'ble MLA Basudevpur suggested to strengthen farmers registration properly & evaluation of existing WSHGs to be done as per guidelines. He also suggested for engagement of Quality Analysts for each PPCs for testing of FAQ paddy norms as well as focused on provision of infrastructures at all PPCs by RMCs. He also suggested to give priority to local millers for smooth lifting of paddy and opening of new PPC at Guagaon under Barandua SCS for Ward No 14 to 18.

The Hon'ble MLA Bhadrak impressed upon to avoid Katni & Chhatni as well as supply of sufficient jute gunny bags to farmers through PPCs. He also emphasized on proper distribution of Paddy Target to all PPCs and care should be taken for lapses of TOKENS. He also suggested for engagement of additional Officer to RMC-Bhadrak to assist the present Secretary. He also suggested for debarment of *Laxmipriya SHG, Baudapur, Sabaranga PACS & Kaupur PACS from Paddy Procurement Operation

President, Zilla Parishad, Bhadrak during course of discussion emphasized on smooth payment of MSP to farmers should be regulated properly.

The representative of Hon'ble M.P, Bhadrak emphasized on engagement of Quality Analysts for all PPCs & testing of FAQ paddy of all registered farmers to avoid Katni & Chhatni. In addition to this, he suggested to purchase maximum paddy of the District through local millers to avoid delay on lifting of Paddy & transportation charges incurred on engagement of other district millers. He also suggested to continue paddy procurement through existing Gaddy SCS under Basudevpur & chance to be given Guamala SCS under Tihidi Bock to participate in procurement. In addition to this, he also suggested to convene 2nd & 3rd DLPC meeting during procurement period.

Representative of Hon'ble MLA Dhamnagar. Bhadrak emphasized on timely procurement of paddy from all farmers and payment of MSP to farmers in a time bound manner.

Representatives of farmers, Sri Nrusingha Parida suggested for timely distribution of target to avoid lapses of TOKENS & engagement of vehicles by millers at Mandis and lifting of paddy thereof.

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Representatives of Millers, Sri Sekhar Mohapatra told that, importance has to be given to local millers in lifting of paddy & allocation of paddy target to be given to the millers against the equivalent delivery of CMR as per guidelines. He also suggested for release of Custom Milling credentials timely & Sri Santosh Agarwalla, the Custom Miller has also suggested to release / clear pending Custom Milling bills for the KMS 2022-23.

14. Decisions taken in the DLPC:-

After through discussion among the members of the DLPC, the following unanimous decisions have been taken up for the KMS 2023-24.

- (a) The Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2023-24 will be commenced with effect from 29.12.2023.
- (b) The entire Mandi Handling Operation i.e heaping of paddy, re-bagging, weighing and loading of paddy bags to the miller's vehicles at Mandi point will be performed by PPCs and the expenditures will be reimbursed to the PPCs, as per approved rate of the OSCSC Ltd.
- (c) As regards to transportation of procured Paddy from PPCs to Rice Mill points is concerned, the DLPC decided that, if the Paddy Transport Contractor for the KMS 2023-24 will not be appointed, the transportation of Paddy from PPCs to Rice Mill points will be done by the millers as usual.
- (d) The Custom Millers dues for the KMS 2022-23 will be settled prior to commencement of Paddy Procurement Operation for the KMS 2023-24. The CSO, Bhadrak has been instructed to take step accordingly.
- (e) Jute gunny bags will be provided to all PPCs by the Millers well in advance for packing of farmer's paddy at Mandi points.
- (f) Basing upon the volume of farmer's registration, the daily target for purchase of paddy at PPCs has been fixed to 700 to 1000 Quintals per day. Accordingly, days of purchase & time has to be fixed.
- (g) RMC Bhadrak and Chandabali will provide all related infrastructures to all PPCs concerned as per guideline by 15.12.2023 positively. In addition to this, both the RMCs will engage temporary quality analysts in respect of all PPCs by 15.12.2023 positively.

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- (h) All PPCs will be covered under CCTV surveillance in order to maintain transparency in paddy procurement. The ARCS, Bhadrak & DSWO, Bhadrak have been instructed accordingly.
- (i) As regards to resignation of following PPCs and in their place, for opening of new PPCs, the Committee unanimously decided to publish Advertisement (EOI) through DSWO, Bhadrak for appointment of new WSHG/GPLF against the vacant PPCs. -

Further, the DLPC has unanimously decided to adhere the followings-


