

ADVERTISEMENT

Applications in the prescribed format(enclosed herewith) are invited from the interested retired Revenue field Officers(only superannuated) i.e. Inspector Technical/Revenue Inspector/Assistant Revenue Inspector/Amin/Draftsman not above the age of 65 years and having good knowledge on preparation of Map and RoR with physical fitness for empanelment at District level for probable engagement in BCP cell at different Tahasil Offices of Bhadrak District on contractual basis for timely completion of BCP work in pursuance of Revenue & Disaster Management Department letter No.RDM-NGE-MISC-0029-2024 43721/R&DM Dated.11.12.2024.

1. The contractual engagement shall be made initially for a period of six month or till completion of BCP work.
2. The terms and conditions are subject to codal provisions, memorandum and Resolution issued by the Finance department from time to time.
3. The appointee has to discharge such duties and in such a manner, as may be prescribed by Government of Odisha from time to time.
4. The retired Govt. employees against whom a Vigilance case or Departmental Proceeding or Criminal Prosecution is contemplated or pending or who has been penalized for misconduct during the period preceding five years of his/her retirement, or is a member of a political party, will not be considered for re-engagement.
5. Consolidated Remuneration of the contractual Officers/Employees shall be fixed as per Govt. in Finance Department Office Memorandum No.24533/F dated.29.09.2022.
6. The period of contractual engagement shall not be counted as Government service for the purpose of pension and any other retirement benefit.
7. The engaged retired employees will be subject to and will abide by the Conduct Rules applicable to the Government Servants.
8. The contractual engagement may be terminated at any time by the Collector, Bhadrak for any misconduct including misappropriation, negligence or causing loss to Government, without conveying any reason thereof.
9. In case the engaged officers desire to resign from the engagement, he may do so by giving a notice of one month in writing to the Collector, Bhadrak. After expiry of the notice period,


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10. The Undersigned reserves the right to reject any/all applications without assigning any reason thereof.
